UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON:

The UH webpage is direct and minimal (to the point). The top header (with a login link, donations, and search) is much smaller whereas the navigation bar has drop downs to the most important information to a visitor. It is obvious of where to find the information you might be looking for. The first image is an eye catching graphic which showcases visual art. Under that is a brief statement about the university and the culture which moves into another banner that has three simple links (visit, apply, studios). This is another small grab to keep the viewer interested and catch them before they leave the site. When then move into a banner with spotlight stories, a photo os one of the buildings, and a footer. In the footer are more detailed links which one would assume would be in a footer such as contact information and socials.

UNIVERSITY OF NORTH TEXAS:

The University of North Texas School of Art's website is similar to the University of Houston where they have minimal information on their homepage and bar that break up the content with links to draw the visitor in (about us, programs of study, etc). The header simply has the search bar and a navigation bar and under that is a banner of scrolling images about the university. One thing different from any university site I have come across is that it has the socials right on the top on that scrolling banner. It could be seen as a bit more chaotic than UH's website simply because there are many more colors and links throughout the pagelike the bars breaking up the sections which is not necessarily applicable to the site. Overall they use the green school color throughout and a logo on the header and footer which keeps it cohesive.

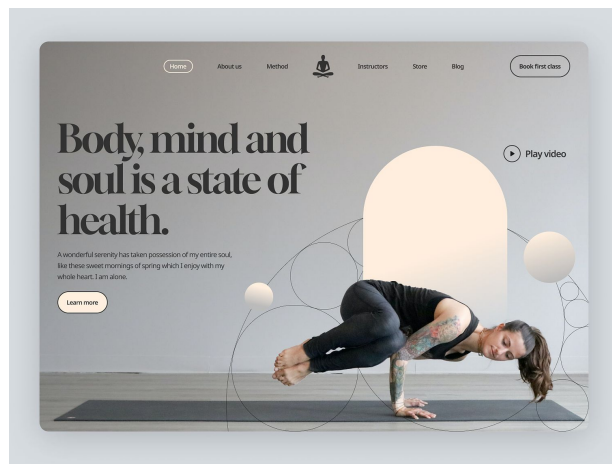
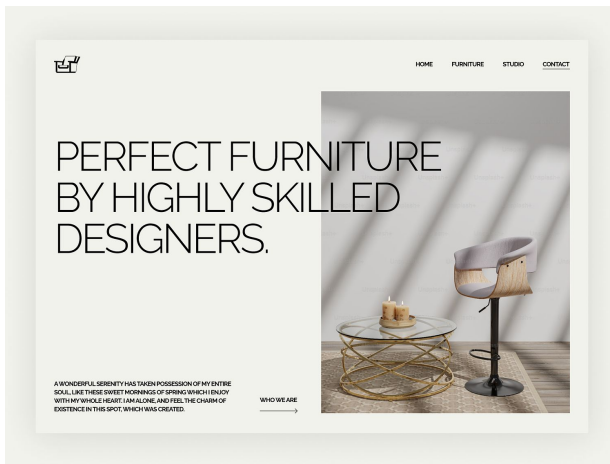
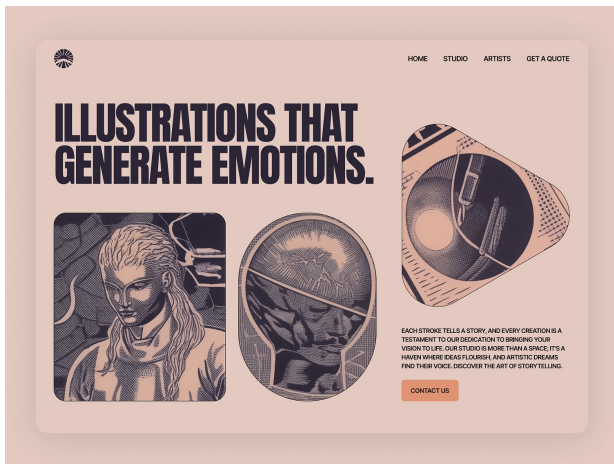
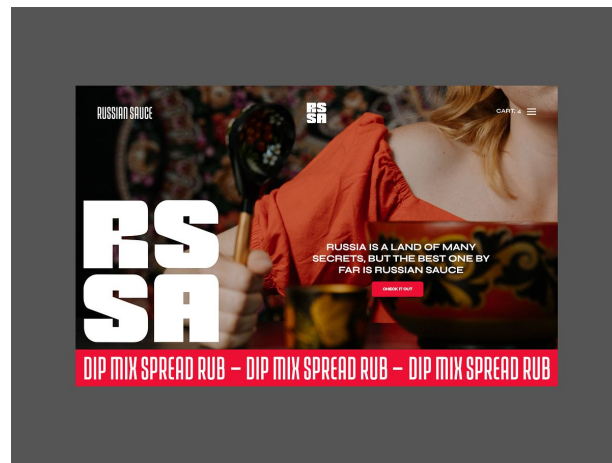
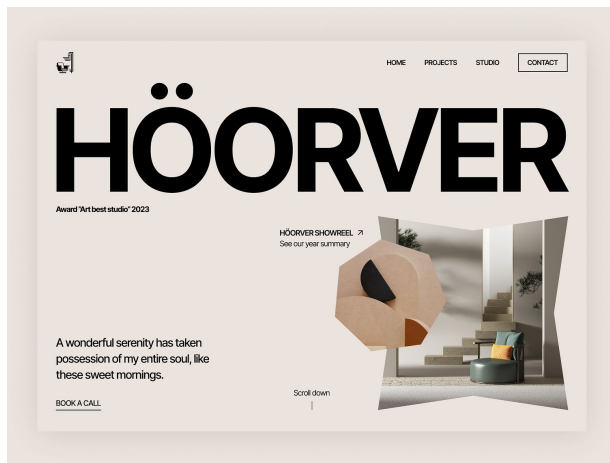
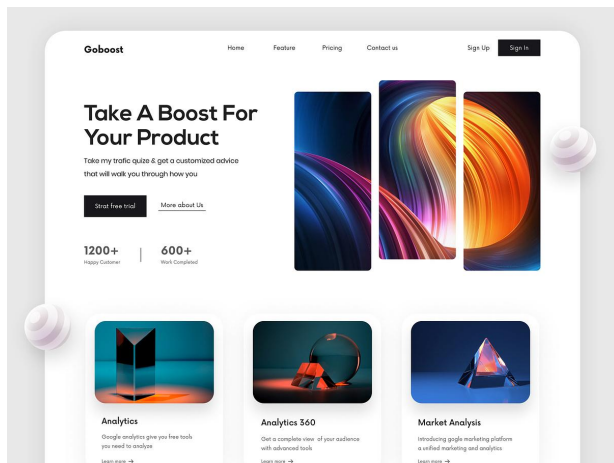
